

Agri-Clinics and Agri-Business Centres (ACABC) Scheme



PAMETI, PAU Campus Ludhiana invites application for two months free residential professional training programme under Agri-clinics and Agri-Business Centres (AC&ABC) Scheme of Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare (MoA & FW), Government of India.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Age: no Bar.
- Qualification:
Agriculture & Allied Sciences graduates from SAUs ICAR/UGC and other Agencies approved by Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India.
OR
Diploma/Post Graduate Course with more than 60% of Course Content in Agriculture & Allied Subjects.
OR
Agriculture Intermediate (i.e. 10+2) pass out with vocational Subject Agriculture & Allied with at least 55% marks.

Features of the Scheme:

- 60 days Residential Programme.
- Free hostel and Mess facility for trainees.
- Exposure visits to Successful Agri ventures.
- After completion of course, Training Certificate will be issued by National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE), Hyderabad.
- Handholding support will be provided by Nodal Training Institute i.e. PAMETI after training up to one year.
- On the basis of Training certificate, students can avail the loan facility from Nationalized banks to start Agricultural Enterprises.
- Individual or Group Projects under Agriculture/ Allied Sector can be started with total project cost up to Rs. 20 Lakhs for Individual and Rs. 100 lakhs for a group of 5 members.
- For General category, 36% subsidy on Total cost of the projects is available and for SC/ST and women candidates, 44% subsidy on total cost of the projects is available.
