National Agripreneurship Awards

MANAGE has again come up this year with National Agripreneurship Awards under Agri-Clinics and Agri-Business Centres (AC&ABC) scheme for the year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2021-22.

National Level Best Training Institutes and State Level Best Agripreneurs will be awarded as per the eligibility criteria of AC&ABC Guidelines 2018.

Eligibility Criteria

Best NTI of the year

Three best NTIs will be awarded at National Level. AC&ABC Award committee will select the Best Nodal Training Institute as per criteria.

Eligibility criteria of NTI:

- 1. Should be an Active NTI for the last 3 years (must have completed at least 3 batches in each of the last 3 years)
- 2. Should have trained at least 250 candidates during last 3 years
- 3. Should have minimum 50% overall success rate in the last 3 years.
- 4. Should be able to demonstrate qualitative success in terms of business excellence and extension services provided by documenting 25 highly successful cases of ventures established during the last 3 years.
- 5. Should have updated MIS database on AC&ABC NIC portal with all respect
- # Once awarded, an NTI may not be considered for award for next three years.

Best Agripreneur of the year

Three outstanding Agripreneurs will be selected for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prizes at state level as per AC&ABC Guidelines 2018.

Eligibility Criteria of Agripreneurs:

- 1. Should have done extension services
- 2. Should have generated employments
- 3. Should have wide coverage of farmers
- 4. Should have strong Agribusiness Model

MANAGE-AC&ABC Agripreneurs Webinar Series

The 15th Webinar in the series was organized on 23rd April, 2022 at 10:00 am IST. The theme for the webinar was **"Revitalizing Dairy Farming into a Profitable Agri-Venture"**.

Mr. Avadhut Kadam, Nodal Officer, Shashwat Sheti Vikas Pratishthan (SSVP), Pune, Maharashtra was the first speaker for the session. He highlighted that the SSVP group is engaged in the Agri-Entrepreneurship Development since 2010. The group was accredited by MANAGE, Hyderabad as a Nodal training Institute for implementing 'AC&ABC Scheme' in Maharashtra, Gujarat & Rajasthan state since 2014. He mentioned that the NTI at Maharashtra has trained 1155 candidates out of which 630 of them have established their agri-ventures exhibiting a success rate of 54.54 percent. The NTI has helped its agripreneurs in establishing agri-ventures in different categories viz. Dairy Farming, Agri-Input Centre, Nursery, PGR production and marketing, Greenhouse, Vegetable Production, Crop Production, Custom Hiring Centres, Food Processing, Poultry, Goatary and Agri-Consultancy.

Mr. Shantanu R Nake, Founder, RS and Sons Agro Vision Pvt. Ltd., Uttar Pradesh was the second speaker for the completed session. Mr. Nake the AC&ABC training from SSVP, Pune. Besides rearing of cattle for milk production and marketing, he focuses heavily on marketing of by-products such as paneer, curd, lassi and ghee. Mr. Nake mentioned that last financial year their turnover was approx. ₹50 lakhs. This year he is expecting it would be ₹2 Cr.+ as they have increased the production from 300 lts. to 600 lts. and shortly it will double up.



Mr. Nilesh Laxman Pote, Founder & CEO, Anand Milk Collection & Dream Dairy Milk Products, Solapur, Maharashtra was the third speaker for the session. Mr. Pote completed the AC&ABC training from SSVP, Pune. He mentioned that the company has two different units one is Anand milk collection and chilling center and second one is Dream Dairy which is engaged in supply and production of Quality Milk Products. We have different types of milk products such as Flavored Lassi, Curd, Shrikhand, Butter Milk and Basundi and sale of products started in OCT 2021. He also sated that the turnover of Anand milk collection is increasing year on year, we have generated total revenue of ₹3.5 Cr in last 4 years. The company has strong procurement network of 500 plus farmers across 15 villages.



The 16th webinar in the series was organized on May 07th, 2022 at 10:00 am IST. The theme for the webinar was **"Beekeeping and Food Processing: Profitable Business Ideas to Scale Up Income".** Dr. D R Meghwal, Nodal Officer, DPR, Kota, RJ, Ms. Priya Malav, Founder, Kota Shahad, RJ and Ms. Rinku Kumari, Founder, Life Grow Kisan, RJ were the speakers for the webinar.
