









2733 Agri-ventures established in 13 Indian States A Review of Annual Progression of AC&ABC Scheme (2022-2023)

The Agri-Clinics and Agri-Business Centres (AC&ABC) is an emerging dynamic scheme for strengthening agri-entrepreneurship skills among unemployed professionals in the sector. agri/allied Βv encouraging entrepreneurship and creating substantial employment prospects for rural youth, it has greatly supplemented public extension leading to rural development. During financial 2022-2023, total 4794 candidates were trained and out of that 2733 Agripreneurs established their agribusinesses in their respective villages by achieving success rate 57.00%. It was revealed that 57.00% of Agripreneurs who started Agriventures were able to prevent rural-to-urban migration in 12 Indian states. A total of 729 established agripreneurs were trained as part of a total 20 Refresher Training Programs that were organized throughout the year with the goal of reviewing, reviving, and advancing the rural-enterprises. A total of 133 Nodal Training partnered Institutes across country conducting training program under AC&ABC scheme during the year 2022-2023.

## National Beekeeping and Honey Mission (NBHM)

#### National Beekeeping and Honey Mission (NBHM):

Govt. of India has approved a new Central Sector Scheme entitled "National Beekeeping & Honey Mission (NBHM)" for 2 years for overall promotion and development of scientific beekeeping in mission mode to achieve the goal of "Sweet Revolution" in the country by giving thrust on capacity building & trainings, specific focus on women, input support for promotion & production, setting up of Integrated Beekeeping Development Centres (IBDCs), other Infrastructures, Digitization /online registration, etc., processing, value addition, market support, etc. & R&D under 3 Mini Missions (MMs)-MM-1, MM-2 & MM-3.



The NBHM will have following sub-schemes/ three Mini Missions: (a) Mini Mission-I: Under this Mission, thrust will be given on production & productivity improvement of various crops through pollination assisted by adoption of scientific beekeeping; (b) Mini Mission-II: This Mission will concentrate on post-harvest management of beekeeping/ beehive products including collection, processing, storage, marketing, value addition, etc. with a thrust to develop requisite infrastructural facilities for these activities; and (c) Mini Mission-III: This Mission will concentrate on Research & Technology generation for different Regions/ States/ Agro-Climatic and Socio-Economic conditions. The NBHM will work in coordination with other Governmental programs / schemes relating to promotion of beekeeping, viz.; MIDH, RKVY, Honey Mission of KVIC, MSME, NLRM/ SLRM, M/o Rural Development, M/o EF&CC, M/o Tribal Affairs, M/o Commerce & Industry, AYUSH, ICAR, etc., for promotion development overall of scientific beekeeping the country. **BENEFITS OF BEEKEEPING:** 

- ❖ Enhances yields & quality of produce of various crops viz., fruits, vegetables, pulses, oil seeds, etc. through pollination support.
- \* Helps in sustainable development of Agriculture, Bio-diversity and Environment.
- Helps in maintaining There is no exception of beekeeping. It is an important input in Agriculture and serves as low cost technology.
- ❖ Increases income of beekeepers/ farmers/ land less labours, etc. through production of honey & other beehive products, viz.; Bees wax, Propolis, Pollen, Royal Jelly, Bee venom, comb honey, etc. which have great importance in human life.

#### MANAGE-AC&ABC Agripreneurs Webinar Series

The 26<sup>th</sup> Webinar in the series was organized on Saturday, February 4<sup>th</sup>,2023 at 10:30 am IST. The theme for the webinar was ""Drone and Value Addition: Improving Entrepreneurship with Smart Farming".

At the start of the webinar, all three speakers extended a heartfelt greeting. The session was directed by Mr. Gajanan Chougule, KVAAF Nodal Officer, Sindhudurg, Maharashtra State. According to Mr. Chaugule, the organization's main goal is to help unemployed agri-professionals develop their agri-entrepreneurship skills in order to boost public extension by offering extension and other services to the farmers. Mr. Chaugule emphasized the KVAAF-Sindhudurg organization's significant accomplishment. Since its beginning, he claimed, the training center has trained 874 candidates in 24 batches, and 475 of those candidates have launched their own agri-businesses in a variety of agricultural activities. He also emphasized the fact that 18 projects received subsidies and 34 projects gained bank loan approval. Finally, he discussed a few successful agricultural agripreneurs who received training and established their agri-ventures under guidance of KVAAF-Sindhudurg.

Mr. Kunal Uttal Patil a founder of Mahalxmi Agricultural Drone was second speaker of the webinar. Mr. Kunal presented the importance of Drone in Agriculture. He said, farmers can benefit from using drones in agriculture because they offer a number of benefits, including increased field capacity and efficiency, faster turnaround times, fewer field operational delays, reduced pesticide and fertilizer waste due to high atomization levels, water savings from ultra-low volume spraying technology compared to conventional spraying methods, and lower spraying and fertiliser application costsHe concludes by encouraging the usage of drones in agricultural operations and smart farming.



Mr. Akshay Kakatkar (M.Sc. Agri), the founder of "Akshay Udyog," spoke prior to the end of session. He narrated his journey of business man. He said the production of pickles and other home-made, value-added goods was accidental. One day, a few visitors visited his house, and as is custom in India, he offered them delectable cuisine. The pickles' flavour was appreciated, and guests inquired as to where they were purchased. It was first time he considered launching a homemade pickle preparation business. He presented about the value added products like fruit juices pickles, squashes and syrup, sundried products, ready to cook products and fruit candy. He also described the tender jackfruit papad recipe and articulates that in a single year 300 tons of the jackfruit value added products were sold out.
