

2593 Women Agripreneurs Established Under **AC&ABC Scheme**

AC&ABC Scheme is a strategic alliance of skilling the agri-business innovative stakeholders, aiming to boost the participation of men/women agripreneurs in nation-building. However, since the commencement of program i.e. 2002, women participation is less as compared to men (8.79 %). At the same time, a large pool of agri-educated women does not consider entrepreneurship as an option, women remain significantly underrepresented in the business sector. In spite of, the MANAGE support mechanisms for enhancing women's entrepreneurship, women are less representing in the flagships program of

AC&ABC Scheme. Till date, a total of unemployed 7596 agripreneurs established their ventures and delivering Spices, Warehouse, Soil laboratory, Custom hiring Nursery, Direct Marketing etc.

agri-professional women were trained and 2593 women extension services at the doorstep of farming community. The women agripreneurs involved in vide ranges of agri-business i.e. Agri-Clinic, Agri-Business Centres, Vet-Pet-Clinic, Dairy, Fishery, Piggery, Manufacturing of Bio-agent, Pest trap, Apiary, Medicinal plantation, Mushroom farming, Agri-tourism, Value addition, testing centre,

RTP on Aqua-Enterprise and Business Opportunities at Fisheries College and Research Institute, Toothukudi, Tamil Nadu









Poultry Industry: Description, Techniques, Types, & Facts Saturday, June 10th, 2023

29th Webinar The of MANAGE-AC&ABC was held on topic "Poultry Industry: Description, Techniques, Types and Facts" on June 10th 2023. Dr. M. Subburajan, the nodal officer Center for Entrepreneurship Development (CED) in Madurai, Tamil Nadu opened the webinar by wishing all the participants a hearty welcome. He provided a full explanation of the objective organisation's enhance employability of educated youth through industry specific skill training, women empowerment and provide capacity building for mass employment generation in rural areas.

He gave a thorough explanation of the organization's goals, which are to support the farming community and help aspiring agripreneurs launch their own businesses. He revealed that in 2017, CED-Madurai, Tamil Nadu, was chosen by MANAGE Hyderabad as a Nodal Training Institute. Since then, the organization has trained 264 candidates in 12 batches, and 111 of those candidates have launched various types of agribusinesses, with a success rate of 42.05 percent in the state of Tamil Nadu. He concluded the presentation by showcasing a few successful agricultural entrepreneurs.

The second speaker was Mrs. Padma Karthika, the founder of Ganesha Guru Layer Farm. She express gratitude the AC&ABC scheme for providing her with a loan of Rs. 25 lakh and the 44% subsidy provided by NABARD under the ACA&BC scheme. She outlined the significance of the Indian poultry industry. She has a business in layer farming and promotes the proverb "an egg a day keeps the doctor away." She provided a thorough presentation on the types of breeds of layer farming, the infrastructure required for layer farming, diseases and their management, hygiene maintenance, vaccination, feeding management, and other topics. She concluded by saying that anyone can start a layer farm with a small investment of money. In India, the layer farming industry is expanding and attracting aspiring agribusiness owners. She said.

The webinar's third speaker was Mr. Selvaraj, founder of Arun Madhan Country Chicken Production. He began by discussing the different types of country chicken, shed location and identification, chick care, native breeds of egg-laying chicken, feeds, medications, and veterinary aids. Additionally, he described the

enemies of the poultry. He has also discussed biological controls for snakes, flies, and rats that are causing poultry more trouble. He stated at the end that country chicken and eggs are more popular these days and therefore, backyard country chicken poultry is growing enterprise in rural area.
