

AC&ABC Scheme Progress Report (2023-2024)



As of March 31, 2024, the AC&ABC scheme progress report for 2023-2024 indicates that a total of 4964 candidates underwent training. Out of this, 2511 candidates successfully established their agri-ventures in various agri-business sectors, resulting in a success rate of 50.58%.

The state with the highest number of trained candidates was Maharashtra, with 1725 candidates, while Uttar Pradesh led in terms of venture establishment with 796 candidates.

The top five states with the highest number of trained candidates and successful venture establishments were Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Madhya Pradesh, and Karnataka. In case of women agripreneurs, a total of 555 women candidates received training, with 243 of them establishing their agriventures, particularly in Agri-Clinics, Dairy, Nursery, Apiary, Custom Hiring Centre etc.

Throughout the year, a series of 20 Refresher Training Programs were conducted with the goal of reviving, and advancing the rural-enterprises. These programs successfully trained a total of 560 experienced agripreneurs.

A total of 134 Nodal Training Institutes across country partnered for conducting training program under AC&ABC scheme during the year 2023-2024.

38th Webinar: Women Agripreneurs in Diversified Agribusiness

Ms. P. Sobharani, Nodal Officer of Center Entrepreneurship Development (CED) in Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh, was the keynote speaker at the event. She expressed her gratitude for being invited to the webinar and welcomed all participants before beginning her presentation.

Mrs. Sobharani highlighted that CED-Vijayawada is the primary Nodal Training Institute in Andhra Pradesh, focusing on promoting entrepreneurship among unemployed agricultural professionals under the AC&ABC scheme since 2019.

She shared statistics regarding the scheme, mentioning that a total of 10 training batches have been completed with 294 candidates trained, out of which 101 have successfully established

ventures, achieving a success rate of 34.35%.

Mrs. Sobharani discussed the strategies for providing support to agripreneurs in terms of establishment and credit assistance. She showcased images from KVKs, field visits to exhibitions, stakeholder meetings, and sensitization sessions for candidates. Additionally, she successful profiles presented have candidates who established businesses under guidance of CED-Vijayawada.

In her final slide, Mrs. Sobharani highlighted that two agripreneurs were honored with the Best Agripreneurs award under the AC&ABC scheme.

Mrs. Jyotsna Bandaru, the founder of Pure Mushroom from Done Atkur Village, Andhra Pradesh, was invited as a motivational women agripreneur during the webinar. She initiated the session by explaining the various types of mushroom varieties along with their distinct growing strategies.

Mrs. Bandaru mentioned that there are 7 types of mushroom varieties being cultivated on her farm. She emphasized the increasing demand for mushrooms in both international and domestic markets, highlighting the potential profitability of

mushroom farming. During her presentation, she showcased visually appealing photographs of mushrooms growing on her farm and detailed the entire process of mushroom farming from spawning to harvest, packing, and transportation for market distribution.

Additionally, she elaborated on the nutritional value and health benefits of mushrooms. Towards the end of her presentation, Mrs. Bandaru shared her experiences of being recognized as the best women entrepreneur with a vision at various events.

Ms. B. Priyanka, the Founder of Vaarahi Agro Services, hailing from Palivela village in Dr B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema District, Andhra Pradesh, she took the stage as the third speaker.

Ms. Priyanka shared that she owns 7 acres of land dedicated to banana cultivation, featuring four different varieties. She delved into the various package of practices aimed at enhancing the yield of banana crops.

Additionally, she shed light on the statistics concerning the Cost: Benefit ratio of cultivating one acre of bananas. Ms. Priyanka also highlighted the other agricultural activities facilitated by Vaarahi Agro Services, such as soil and water

testing laboratory services, landscaping consultancy, and nursery services. The soil and water testing lab plays a crucial role in assisting farmers in analyzing their lands. Based on the lab reports, farmers receive guidance on the appropriate cropping patterns and the correct doses of agricultural inputs.

This, in turn, leads to a reduction in cultivation costs and an increase in benefits for the farmers.
