

43rd Webinar: "AC&ABC Boosting Efficiency in Smart Farming"




The 43rd MANAGE-ACABC webinar was conducted on August 24, 2024, at 10:30 AM IST. The theme of the webinar was "AC&ABC Boosting Efficiency in Smart Farming." The speakers included Rakesh Kumar Shukla from CTED, AMETI, Mr. Shubham Mishra, CEO of SP Agriclinic, and Mr. Mayank Mishra. The session aimed to explore innovative approaches and technologies to enhance efficiency in smart farming practices.
