AGRIPRENEUR OF Age no bar for Agripreneurship — Dr. Shesha Reddy, Agri Entrepreneur, Andhra Pradesh



Seventy-year-old Dr. B. Sesha Reddy, retired as professor of Agriculture Economics from Acharya N. G. Ranga Agriculture University, Andhra Pradesh . Underwent Agri Clinic and Agri Business Training programme in an institute Participatory Rural Development Initiatives (PRDIS) at Hyderabad. The training programme inspired him to take up consultancy services at his native

place Nandyala in the year 2007 in the name of B.S.R. Agri Clinic to serve the farming community. He obtained a loan of Rs. 10 lacs from State Bank of India and acquired necessary equipment for soil and water testing. He is covering around 400-450 farmers in 10-12 villages around Nandyal and providing consultancy in improving soil fertility, market information for important crops like Paddy, Bengal Gram. He also encouraged his son an MBA graduate to take up seed production on behalf of Nuzuveedu seeds. At present his annual income is around Rs. 2 lacs per annum. Apart from the above services Dr. Reddy is associated with Diploma in Agricultural Extension Services for Input Dealers programme of National Institute of Agriculture Extension Management

(MANAGE) and National Horticulture Board (NHB) schemes. He is also a visiting faculty to Agriculture College Mahanandi. He encouraged Shri. B. Nageshwar Rao of Nandyala, a post graduate in Agriculture to take up seed processing after undergoing Agri Clinics and Agribusiness Centres 🛮 Scheme (ACABC) training which is run by Nagaeshwar successfully at Nanadyala.
